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- hereinafter jointly called the **TRUSTEES** (which expression shall unless excluded by or repugnant to the subject or context be deemed to include the Trustee or Trustees for the time being of these presents and / or survivor or survivors of any of them and their successor or successors - in - office) of the **OTHER PART**.

**WHEREAS:**

**WHEREAS THE SETTLOR** out of humanity and natural love to the society is desirous of settling the **TRUST** of handing over a sum of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) to the **TRUSTEES** with the intention that they shall hold the said sum and income arising therefrom **TRUST** subject to the power and provisions hereinafter / herein Group declared of convening the same which the **TRUSTEES** have agreed to do and all the donation contributions, additions, accumulations to the said money and conversion thereof and invest in which the same way from time to time be invested in the Trust or be received by them by way of donations or acquired by them or may come into their hands by virtue of these presents or by otherwise howsoever in relation to the Trust hereby created, hereinafter referred to as "**THE TRUST FUND**" i.e. the "Trusty Property".

**AND WHEREAS** with a view to and for the purpose of constituting the Trust permanently for the purpose of carrying on the objectives of the Trust as mentioned hereafter under the "Aims and Objects" clause of this Deed of Trust, it is considered desirable that for the purpose of creation of this Trust the declaration of the Trust should be made in the manner set out hereunder.

**NOW THIS DEED WITNESSETH** as follows:

**Name of the Trust :- THE ABACUS EDUCATIONAL & WELFARE TRUST**

The Registered Head Office of the Trust be located at Dankuni Station Pally (North), P.O. :- Dankuni, Dist- Hooghly, Pin - 712311, West Bengal, India, the office of the Trust may be opened to any other place in West Bengal or to any other of India or open local office, regional office, city office or offices at places deemed necessary.

**INTERPRETATION :-**

- a) **TRUST** means the Trust created by this.
- b) The **Board** shall mean the Board of the members which may be filled up by co-option of the existing Trustees created by the Deed with renowned and suitable persons.
- c) **TRUST PROPERTY** shall include every kind of property movable and immovable to be owned by the Trust and mentioned in accounts, books and other documents in the possession, custody and control of that ought to be in possession, custody and control of possession of the **TRUST**.
- d) The Trust shall have a common Seal, Logo, Emblem of such 'Make' and 'Design' as recommended by The Board of Trustees.



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## 1. AIMS AND OBJECTS OF TRUST:-

- I) English Medium High School known as "THE ABACUS CENTRAL SCHOOL" / "THE ABACUS HIGH SCHOOL" (From nursery to Class-XII) under Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) / ICSE / ISC/ ANY STATE BOARD accompanied with trade like state of welfare in which the students may learn a stress free education to compete with measuring of international level, throughout the India with different branches, under control of the trust
- II) Technical College / Institution Known as "THE ABACUS MANAGEMENT & TECHNICAL INSTITUTION" will be started their activities in near future throughout the India with different branches, under control of this Trust.
- III) B.Ed. , M.Ed, D.Ed. Montessori Teacher's Training College / Institution will be started their activities in near future throughout the India with different branches, under control of this Trust.
- IV) Toddler / Play School for pre nursery students will be started their activities in near future throughout the India with different branches, known as "THE ABACUS PLAY SCHOOL"
- V) Disabled / Special Child's School known as "ANUBHOB" will be started their activities in near future throughout the India, under control of this Trust.
- VI) Various Aboard Studies / Vocational Courses Like ABACUS METHODOLOGY, BRAIN JIM, MENTAL MATH, SPOKEN ENGLISH, COMPUTER LITERACY, SKILL DEVELOPMENT etc. will be started their activities in near future throughout the India, under control of this Trust.
- VII) It is a prime need of formation of one well guided administration in favour of all the educational institution which will be formed by some well-wishers and selected persons. Therefore, formation such Managing Committee of the institute which is to be framed in accompanying by the representatives of Students (if need), Guardians, representatives of such Teaching and Non Teaching Staff and other well recognized persons of this locality who will look after the Academic-Management and welfare works in favour of those educational Institutions and this managing Committee may be formed by Settler of this Trust through a fair selection and the existence of this Managing Committee will be stable minimum 6 month and maximum 3 years in continuity of its period. and if it is needed to terminate any Member (for his misbehavior, unwanted conduct and detection of any type of detrimental to the interest of School/College), holding of any post, the settler can take the type of intervention of termination of the said member by dent of the supreme authority remained in his power as usual.



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- VIII) Trust may open several Savings Bank Accounts in the Name of Trust i.e. "THE ABACUS EDUCATIONAL AND WELFARE TRUST", in the name of School i.e. "THE ABACUS CENTRAL SCHOOL" / "THE ABACUS HIGH SCHOOL" in the name of technical institution i.e. "THE ABACUS MANAGEMENT & TECHNICAL COLLEGE" etc. in the name of Institutions / branches throughout the India, The said Bank Accounts are operated by the President/Settler of "THE ABACUS EDUCATIONAL AND WELFARE TRUST" / President of MANGING COMMITTEE duly appointed by trust through election / selection and should be countersigned by Secretary or Treasurer in issuing of any cheque or withdrawal of any cash. The president must be a Compulsory Signatory whereas anyone of two trustee / managing committee members Secretary or Treasurer is co signatories.
- IX) Trust may give franchises of their all types of educational institution to suitable person / organization (Policies, terms & conditions of franchises may decided through Board Meeting) for increase their educational support to all students throughout the India.
- X) TO alleviate poverty in a sustainable and sustained manner of ever larger numbers of poor people, particularly poor women.
- XI) TO facilitate entrepreneurial activities by provision of micro credit to poor needy women. It will also work to encourage savings habit amongst such poor people. It will work to help create financial resources to serve the poor women and their families to tide over the many emergencies they face regularly, such as ill health, etc. The Trust will work to facilitate overall social development of poor women, their families and their communities to the degree possible with minimal possible additional financial input. The Trust will work to help establish institutions to do all of the above in a sustained and sustainable manner for the long run.
- XII) TO arrange to locate suitable for the purpose of arranging suitable accommodation of office space / room for the utilization of the Trust.
- XIII) TO help the needy students of all communities for getting better opportunities for education and higher studies.
- XIV) TO engage and assists in such other philanthropies activities as may be appropriate by the Trustees of the Trust.
- XV) TO do all such things, deeds, acts and matters as may be deemed incidental or conducive to attainment of the foregoing objects.
- XVI) TO attempt for the improvement of village educational and economic structure through establishment of educational institutes and villages industries for the benefits of the rural people.
- XVII) TO acquire, establish, start, aid, run, maintain or manage school, colleges, libraries, health clinic for the benefit of the poor people.

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- XVIII) TO render services to the students providing necessary education or management study, education study, pharmacology study, compute science, non-formal education, etc.
- XIX) TO arrange and organize lectures, debates, discussion, seminars, excursions, examinations for the diffusion of knowledge.
- XX) TO published or caused to be published useful literature papers, magazines, books, souvenirs.
- XXI) TO promote and encourages advancement of literacy, cultural, research and developmental work, scientific and technical education and engineering products and assisting to start Industrial Co-operative Society.
- XXII) TO do any other matter / work / objects formation Self Help Groups (SHG's) / Micro Finance as may be assigned and conveyed. Also start Community Development through SHG's formation so the poor people may be benefited for availing financial assistance (micro credit) from our organization.
- XXIII) TO collect and preserve manuscripts paintings, sculptures, works of art, antiquities, natural history specimens, mechanical and scientific instrument and designs.
- XXIV) TO affiliate itself with such other recognized institutes, societies, bodies whose objects are fully or in parts similar.
- XXV) TO undertake different training programmes and income generating programmes for the upliftment of the poorer section of the society.
- XXVI) TO receive grant, donation and loans from Government departments, national and international agencies, institutions and individuals for doing all non - governmental organization's work throughout India for the development of the poorer section of the society in rural, semi-urban and urban areas.
- XXVII) TO help the aged, sick and indigent persons and to open old age home and day care centre for the aged for both sexes of 60 years and above.
- XXVIII) TO maintain, improve, develop and alter any buildings, houses or other works necessary or convenient for the purpose of the development in the community.
- XXIX) TO promote wherever possible, social forestry, environmental and ecological development, agricultural farming, nursery raising, pisciculture, aqua culture, Bee keeping, Fish farming, dairy, duckry poultry, goatery and food processing units.
- XXX) TO promote handicrafts and Handloom development programmes and encourage to develop handloom woven cloth (Khadi) for the benefit of the poor craft persons and weavers and to sell products in the common market or in exhibition for raising funds of the Trust for doing development work in the community.



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- XXXI) TO open Creches, short stay Home, Nursery and Kindergarten School, Music School and to open cottage scheme for orphanage boys and girls as and when committee will deem fit.
- XXXII) TO participate in trading activities incidental to the foregoing objects of the Trust.
- XXXIII) TO undertake research and development work for the upliftment of the tribal people.
- XXXIV) TO undertake educational development programme and vocational training cum income generating programme or others which may be deemed fit for physical and mentally retarded persons.
- XXXV) TO undertake relief and rehabilitation programme for the distressed people during natural and /or manmade disaster viz., drought, flood, earthquake, fire, war, etc.
- XXXVI) TO undertake all kinds of programme related to health and hygiene, mother and child care, family welfare, medical care, mobile medicare unit, medical assistance and also to organize health camps alongwith health clinics.
- XXXVII) TO establish eco-tourism, park, garden and others for the benefit of the environment.
- XXXVIII) TO give economic assistance to the youth and rural farmers and rural artisans to start small entrepreneurship and supply of products like food, minerals, clothing and garment materials and making or any other items produced by the weaker section of the society for their substance.
- XXXIX) TO raise subscription from the well off people to channelize that support to the poorest of the poor people through providing food and other materials (following ration system)
- XL) TO run & continue this service and support program throughout all parts of India
- XLI) TO Collect Savings Deposit, Recurring Deposit, Fixed Deposit, Debenture from open market for benefit of the people
- XLII) TO facilities entrepreneurial activity by provision of micro credit to poor needy women. It will also work to encourage savings habit amongst such poor people. It will work to help create financial resources to serve the poor women and their families to tide over the many emergencies they face regularly, such as ill health etc. The Society will work to facilitate overall social development poor women, their families and their communities to the degree possible additional financial input. The Society will work to help establish institutions to do all of the above in a sustained and sustainable manner for the long run.
- XLIII) TO do any other matter / work / objects formation Self Help Groups (SHG's) / Micro Finance as may be assigned and conveyed. Also start Community Development through SHG's formation so the poor



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people may be benefited for availing financial assistance (micro credit) from our organization.

- XLIV) TO raise funds for charity performance Govt. Grant, Public Donation, Thrift Fund and to borrow fund from Commercial / R.R.B.S. / Co-operative Bank and Non-Govt. Financial Institution and to get deposit from the members of the Self Help Groups and Individual and from the Society with a view to lend money to the members of the Self Help Groups and Individuals from making them Self-Sufficient Activities of the SOCIETY.
- XLV) TO strive towards economic empowerment of the marginalized, in particular of women, aimed at self-reliance and self-sufficiency, by providing opportunities for self-employment through micro-credit financing and formation of cluster of Self Help Groups (SHGs).
- XLVI) TO provide micro-credit facilities to Self Help Groups (SHGs) to enable their members to redeem their mortgaged lands and loans from money lenders and thus break the vicious circle of indebtedness the poor are trapped in.
- XLVII) TO link SHGs to the Banks, Government infrastructures and other institutions for socio economic development through micro-credit facilities.
- XLVIII) TO build the capacity of SHGs in view of making them self-sufficient and self-reliant in managing the affairs of their groups.
- XLIX) TO assist in the development of Self Help Groups (SHGs) of farmers including small and marginal farmers, artisans, labour including agricultural labour and other service providers with special emphasis on women, youth, differentially-abled and other disadvantaged sections for accelerating the pace of rural development.
- L) TO render technical guidance and assistance to Self Help Groups (SHGs) in regard to production and income generating activities undertaken by them.
- LI) TO undertake marketing research of market information for the benefit of Self Help Groups (SHGs) entrepreneur.
- LII) TO open and run emporia for facilitating marketing of products, produced by Self Help Groups (SHGs).
- LIII) TO avail loan facility from banks or other government authorized bodies or sources of women entrepreneurship assistance and development.
- LIV) TO raise loans from banks or authorized sources for lending micro loans to women self help group members.
- LV) TO provide micro loan facility to the women self help group members for their economic/business activities so that they use the facility properly, profit and repay the society with interest amount.
- LVI) TO raise loans from banks or other authorized sources for building infrastructure facility, developmental facilities and so on.



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- LVII) TO raise loans from banks or other authorized sources/bodies for economic, social, welfare related and business oriented activities of the society in the interest of women, children and adolescents.
- LVIII) TO promote/implement Micro Credit Organisation from the benefit of women self help groups to help them in their economic endeavours.
- LIX) TO facilitate Gold Loan to individuals against security of gold ornaments owned by them for the purpose of agricultural activities, allied activities and relevant activities.

2. The Trustees may accept any donation or contribution / loan in Cash or Kind from any person, Firm, Company, Corporation, Association, Institutions or Trust (including the Trustees or of them) **NATIONAL & INTERNATIONAL AGENCIES** for the furtherance of the objects of the Trust or for any one or more of them upon such terms and conditions as they may in their absolute discretion think fit and proper and which are not inconsistent with the objects of the Trust.

- i) TO borrow if needed by against the security of the assets of the Trust by way of Bank Overdraft, Loan otherwise as may be necessary, for the benefit of the Trust and for more effectively carrying out the objects of the Trust provided however the trustees unanimously agree on such borrowing and limited to the terms of their decision or agreement and to authorize two or more of the Trustees to execute such documents, deeds, papers, etc., as may be necessary in connection therewith.
- ii) TO arrange for and / or authorized the signing or execution of any agreement, contract, instrument, documents or any other paper or writing required to be signed or executed on behalf of the Trustees by any two of the Trustees to be nominated in this behalf of the Board of Trustees and to make same effective and binding as if the said agreement, contract, instrument or documents or paper or writing were signed by all the Trustees.
- iii) The Trustee or Trustees shall out of the Income of the Trust property viz., Rent, Profit, thereof, etc., pay all costs, charges and expenses of or incidental to the maintenance and administration of the Trust property.
- iv) TO authority any one or more Trustees to held any property or any fund or any investment of the Trust subject to the terms and conditions as the Board of Trustees approved.
- v) All cheques shall be signed by any two of the following as cheque signing Authority in the Bank (1) Chairman, (2) Secretary, (3) Treasurer from the Trustees be appointed by the Trust Board. The Trustees will be liberty to open Bank Account in any bank of their choice to avail Banking facilities and the accounts shall be operated by the above designated persons.
- vi) TO appoint or make provision for the appointment of a sub - committee and / or others to attend or to supervise or to conduct specified jobs or functions or trust matters in such manner and subject to such Rules and Regulations as the Trustee prescribe.



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vii) TO erect, construct, alter, maintain, sell, lease, mortgage, pledge, hypothecate, lien, improve, develop, manage and control all or any part of the Property or Building, Gold or Silver of the above society, against borrowing, pledge, hypothecate, guarantee, mortgage necessary or convenient of the use of the amendment of the aims and objects of the society, or in any forms as required by lending institutions (SIDBI, NABARD, HUDCO, RMK, NMDFC, National / International / Private Bank or any lending institution).

3. To perform that notwithstanding herein contained in the income as the corpus OF THE TRUST fund the same shall be applicable and applied to for PUBLIC CHARITABLE PURPOSE within such territories and subject to such conditions or limitation if any as may from time to time be laid down by the Income Tax Act, 1961, or any other acts governing taxation of income the wealth of PUBLIC CHARITABLE / WELFARE TRUST so as to render the TRUST hereby established as well as its income eligible for exemption from taxation under such Act or Acts now or prevalling or any modification replacement thereof.

4. To act in such a way that the TRUST hereby established shall always retain the status of one such TRUST to which provisions of section 80G/12A/35AC/FCRA/ 10(23C)IV/V/VIA of the Income Tax Act, 1961 or any modification replacement of thereof for the time being in force shall apply so that any donation of contribution thereto is recognized as eligible for exemption or relief from tax in the hands of the donor.

5. The number of Trustees shall be not less than 2 nor more than 11 Trustees and shall continue in office until the trustee dies or become insolvent or resigns his office as Trustees and upon the happening of any such event the trust may nominate and appoint a successor in consultation with the Chairman, Secretary of the Trust, who shall thereupon become a trustee in place of such Trustee so ceasing to be a Trustee.

6. The Trustees for the time being shall elect from amongst them one Chairman and Secretary, they shall hold office for years, unless he resigns or refuses to act as Chairman or otherwise case to be trustee.

a) Note of Trust Board meeting in writing shall be sent to every Trustee by the Secretary specifying the place, date and hour of the meeting with a statement of business transacted thereat at least 7 (seven) days before the date of the meeting.

A special meeting at any time after giving 3 (three) days notice in advance.

An emergency meeting at any time after giving 24 (twenty four) hours notice in advance.

b) A requisition meeting containing special agenda and signed three trustees holding office for the time being within fifteen days from the date of such requisition or otherwise whatsoever.

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- c) Provided further that all aforesaid meeting shall be valid if those are called / convened by the Chairman or Secretary as the cases demand or by one third trustees holding office for the time being respectively as the case may be.
7. Two – Third ( $2/3^{\text{rd}}$ ) Trustees at a Meeting shall form a quorum for any meeting of the trustees.
  8. The minutes of the proceedings of every meeting of the Trustee shall be entered in a Book to be kept for that purpose and signed by the Chairman and Secretary of such meeting or at the following meeting when they are read over and shall when so entered and signed be conclusive evidence of the business and other matters transacted at such meeting.
  9. That all proceedings and questions and matters arising at the meeting of the Trustees shall be decided by a majority of Votes and in case of equality of votes the Chairman shall have a Second or casting vote.
  10. A Resolution in writing circulated amongst all the Trustees and signed by a majority of the Trustees shall be as valid and effectual as if it had been passed at a meeting of the Trustees duly called and convened.
  11. A Trustee who is unable to be present at a meeting of the Trustees may send his views on the agenda in writing and such expression of opinion shall be taken to be his vote on the matter concerned.
  12. A Trustee of the Board of Trustees shall be cease to be a Trustee of the Board of Trustees of (a) he resigns by letter addressed to the Secretary, (b) he absents himself from three consecutive meetings of the Governing Body without any leave or without any reasonable ground, (c) he is convicted of any offence in connection with formation, promotion management or conduct of affairs of a Trust or of a body Corporate, or of any offence involving moral turpitude. This decision shall be taken in the quorum of the Board of Trustees meeting.
  13. The board of Trustee shall be responsible for the safe custody of the funds and assets of the Trust.
  14. The funds of the Trust shall be kept at the Banker's custody to be appointed by the board and to be invested in any securities abiding by the norms and laws of the Income Tax Act. also the India Trust Act.
  15. In the event of all the Trust Funds getting exhausted in carrying out the object of the said Trust, or any of them, or under any adverse situation that may arise compelling discontinuance of the said Trust the TRUST created by the said deeds will never come to an end and Trustees shall try their best to arrange for necessary fund and to carry on the objects of, the said Trust and in the event of failure to do so, to amalgamate the said Trust with any other Trust having similar object. In the even of failure to s the assets over liabilities will be transferred and / or amalgamated to any other Trust or Association having similar object.
  16. No act or proceeding of the trust shall be deemed to be invalid by reason merely f any vacancy in the committee or any defect in the constitution of the trust of the board of trustee.



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17. The rules of the trust may be altered at any time by resolution passed by the two – third (2/3<sup>rd</sup>) members of the board of trustee at any meeting which shall have been convened for the purpose.

18. The board shall have powers to make such bye-laws as it deems fit for requisition of the business of the board, it can also amend such bye-laws.

**19. OFFICE BEARERS :-**

Office bears of the trust shall be initially as follows

The Board of Trustees is also Empowered to created any office bearer post and elect office bearers to fill up the post from the Trustees and /or from outside the Board of Trustees. The above office bearers shall be elected by the co-option of the Trustee at a meeting convened for the purpose.

**20. FUNCTION OF THE OFFICE BEARERS:**

a) **President:** The President shall exercise the following powers and duties :

i) President will be elected in a meeting by the majority of the trustees present and convened for that purpose. ii) The President will preside over all the meeting of the Trust and conduct the proceedings. iii) The President in his own discretion or by the request of one-third of existing Trustees can call for a meeting of the Trustees. iv) The President is empowered to delegate such power to the Secretary or any other Trustees of the Trust as he may deem fit. v) The President shall have the power to dismiss or remove or take appropriate disciplinary action against any office bearers, staffs and any sub-committee or its members on valid grounds, at any time in accordance with principles of natural justice and in consultation with the Board of Trustees.

b) **Secretary :**

The Secretary shall exercise the following powers and duties :

i) The Secretary of the Board of Trustees and the Executive Committee will be elected in a meeting by the majority of trustees present. ii) The Secretary shall conduct and manage all the affairs of the Trust, its properties and institutions, sign papers and carry on correspondence on behalf of the Trust and shall be responsible for the safe custody of record of the Trust. iii) The Secretary shall also perform such other duties as may be entrusted to him time by the Board of Trustees, provided that in the absence of the Secretary, the other Trustee specially authorized by the Board of Trustees may sign papers and carry on correspondence on behalf of the Trust and do all or any or the duties relating to the Secretary under this clause. iv) The Secretary shall attend to the correspondence and day to day affairs of the Trust. v) The Secretary shall carry out all the resolutions of Trust and for that purpose he shall have power to incur necessary expenditure from and out of the funds of the Trust, subject to a maximum of Rs. 20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) only and anything in

excess of Rs. 20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) only is to be incurred with the sanction of the Board of Trustees. The Secretary shall have the custody of the correspondence and other books relating to the affairs of the Trust.

**d) Treasurer :**

The Treasurer shall collect and receive all sorts of subscriptions, donations and deposits and deposits of money and grant receipts of money and shall keep proper accounts thereof. He or she will maintain and keep Cash Book and such other Accounts as are necessary.

**21. DISSOLUTION CLAUSE:**

In the event of dissolution or winding of the trust, the assets remaining as on date of dissolution shall under no circumstances be distributed among the trustees/members of the managing committee/Governing body, but the same will be transferred to another Charitable Trust/Society whose objects are similar of those of this Trust and which enjoys recognition under section 80 G of the Income Tax Act 1961 as amended from time to time.

22. The Trust formed shall be irrevocable.

23. The benefits of the Trust shall be open to all irrespective of caste creed and religion.

24. **BANK OPERATION :** To open Bank Account of the trust and other institution / school / college under control the Trust in any scheduled or Nationalized Banks of Co-Operative Banks or Private Banks of Any Branch of India (where necessary) as may be decided upon by trust from time to time and to close such accounts and to open new once in any such bank or banks providing the operation by President, Secretary, Treasurer Jointly or as shall be decided mutually in meeting of the TRUSTEE BOARD.

25. **INDEMNITY :** The Board of Trustee shall be indemnified for any act done by them in good faith in the course of the administration of the Trust.

26. **APPLICABILITY OF TRUST ACT:** The provisions of the Indian Trust Act 1882 shall apply to all matters not specifically mentioned in these presents.

**27. AREA OF OPERATION:**

The Trust will not give emphasize in West Bengal but will work in the entire Geographical boundary of INDIA.

**DECLARATION:**

This Trust and Scheme set forth under Indenture shall come into force immediately after the execution and registration thereof.
